

ESSENTIAL SECURITY TIPS:

8 The chats stored on your phone are readily available to law enforcement when the power is on, even if locked.

9 Power down your phone if there is any chance it might leave your possession.

10 Do not use full legal name or photo in your Signal profile. To change: Settings > press your profile name.

11 Do not say anything incriminating in a large Signal group.

KEY PRIVACY FEATURES

1 Face Blur
Use the built-in tool to blur faces in photos before sending

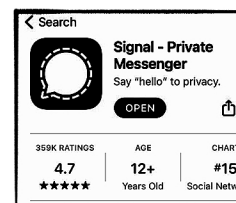
2 Read Receipts:
Toggle these in Settings > Privacy to control delivery/read notifications.

3 Disappearing Messages:
In chat settings, you can set messages to disappear after a certain time.

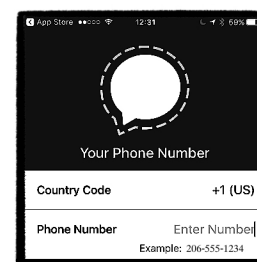
4 View Once Media:
Tap the infinity icon next to a photo/video before sending to make it disappear after viewing.

DOWNLOAD & SETUP:

1 Get Signal from your phone's App Store.



2 Open the app and follow the prompts.



MESSAGES & CALLS

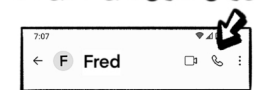
1 Start a chat:
Tap the compose (pen/pencil) icon, choose a contact, write your message, and send.



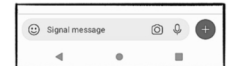
2 Send Media:
Tap the attachment icon (paper clip) to add photos, videos, or files.



3 Voice/Video Calls:
In a chat, tap the phone or video camera icon to start a secure call.



4 Voice Messages:
Press and hold the microphone icon to record and send a voice message.
